

## 1 Log into the MDT

- To login, enter a **User Name** and **Password**, swipe a magnetic card, or press an iButton to the MDT.

## 2 Update your Status to ON DUTY

This step is not required if you are set up for automated Driver Logs

- From the main screen, press
- Press

## 3 Sync the MDT (if required)

**When to Sync the MDT:**

- When changing vehicles
- To correct inaccurate or missing information
- When a DOT official requests a driver check
- To resolve long/lat information to addresses

- From the Daily Log chart, press
- Wait until the synchronizing message closes and press

## 4 Submit a Pre-Trip Inspection Form

**How to Send an Electronic Form**

- From the main menu, press
- Turn knob to scroll to the form.
- Press
- Scroll to a field. Press
- Use the keypad to enter information
- Press knob to submit information.
- To send the form, press

## 5 Update your Status to DRIVE

- From the Daily Log chart, press

★ After logging in, the first screen opens to either the **Main Screen** or the **Driver Daily Log Chart (DOT)**.

### Main Screen

This screen opens after you log in and without automated Driver Logs.



### Driver's Daily Log Chart/Grid

This screen opens after you log in with automated Driver Logs; you are also automatically placed **ON Duty**.



### Navigation Tips

Press **CLR** to step back one screen at a time or return to the main screen

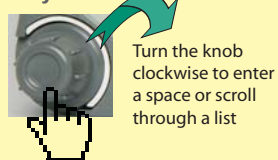
### MSG & ACK Lights

The MSG light flashes red and the MDT beeps 5 times (default) when a message or form is received

A solid red MSG light means there are unread messages

The ACK light flashes green while sending a message and stops when done

### Rotary Knob



Press the knob to select an item, send a form/message, or wake up the terminal

★ Give these instructions to any Official who stops to check your HOS compliance

From any Driver Log screen, press the 4 and 6 keys to scroll the 15 days of driving history and violations

**Press 4** to go back one day at a time

**Press 6** to go forwards one day at a time

To get to the Driver Daily Log Chart from the main screen press

Available for FW versions 4.1.108 & higher

From the screen above, **press 5** on the keypad to see a list of violations by duty cycle group.

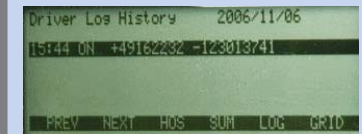
- The Duty Cycle group name is displayed in the top left corner including the total distance driven & still available.
- Overages are in square brackets e.g. [45]
