



HOS Procedures for Hy-rail Vehicles

Webtech Driver Center provides special modes to ensure HOS (Hours of Service) are recorded correctly for Hy-rail vehicles.

While in Rail Mode or Yard Mode, vehicle activity only counts against ON DUTY hours, not against DRIVING hours.

Starting your shift

1. Log in to Webtech Driver Center.
2. Add your trip information, then tap **Yard Mode** to enable it:

While in Yard Mode, any vehicle movement is calculated as ON DUTY, not DRIVING Hours, saving you valuable driving time:

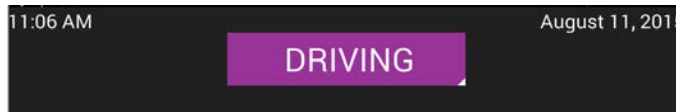


3. Perform your pre-trip inspection(EDVIR):



During your shift

1. When you leave the yard for the job site, Driver Center switches out of Yard Mode and starts recording DRIVING hours, based on a preconfigured speed threshold:



2. When you arrive at the job site and engage your Hy-rail, Driver Center automatically switches into Rail Mode:



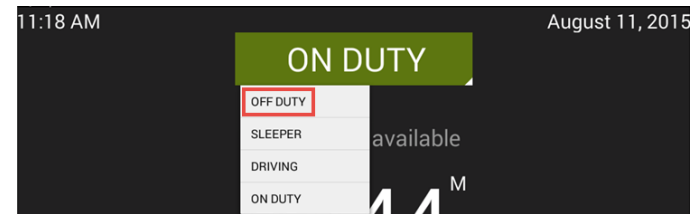
While in Rail Mode, all vehicle movement is recorded as ON DUTY hours, not DRIVING hours.

Ending your shift

1. When your shift is done, park the vehicle (either on the rails or in a yard).

If you need to disengage Hy-rail, Driver Center automatically switches from Rail Mode to ON DUTY status.

2. Perform a post-trip inspection (EDVIR), then change your status to OFF DUTY:



Note: if you have trouble changing status, ensure the vehicle is not in gear, or turn off the ignition and select OFF DUTY again.

3. Tap the driver name, then tap **Log Out**.
