

Driver Center MDT3300 Hotsheet

Wi-Fi Pairing – Pair the MDT with the vehicle:

1. Turn on the vehicle's ignition.
2. In **Settings > Wireless & Networks**, enable Wi-Fi and disable Bluetooth.
3. Tap **Wi-Fi** and look for a network named "WT10X-" followed by the last 4 digits of the locator serial number.
4. The full 8-digit serial number is the network password.
Contact a system admin if you need assistance.



Logging In

Open the Webtech Driver Center app.
Enter your username and password (both 4 digits).



Verifying Main Driver Information

1. Tap **Log Book > Summary**.
2. Set your HOS Mode to **Canada 7/70** or **USA Passenger 8/70**.
3. Home Terminal, Time Zone, and Carrier are auto-populated.



Submitting Forms

1. Tap **New Form** in the **Messages** section.
2. A drop-down menu of available options appears.



Viewing Messages

Tap **Message** at the bottom of the screen to view received messages.

Sending Messages

Tap **Quick Message** for canned messages.
Tap **New Message** to send a text.



Manually Changing Duty Status

Tap your current status on the **HOS** screen and select your new status.



Logging Out

1. **VERY IMPORTANT:** Make sure your status is **Off Duty (HOS screen)**.
2. Tap your name (bottom left).
3. Tap **Log Out**.



Viewing Your Logs – There are 4 tabs in the Logbook section.

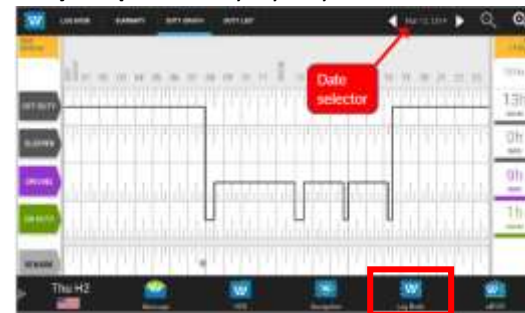
Logbook tab: manual sync & inspection mode



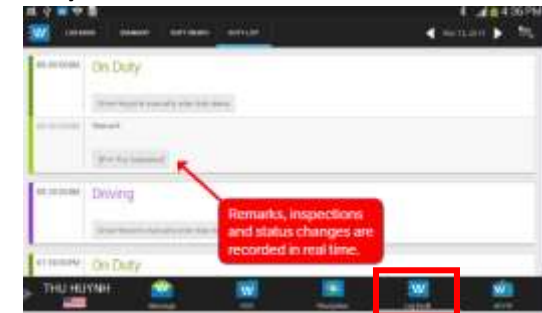
Summary tab: remaining hours in daily cycle

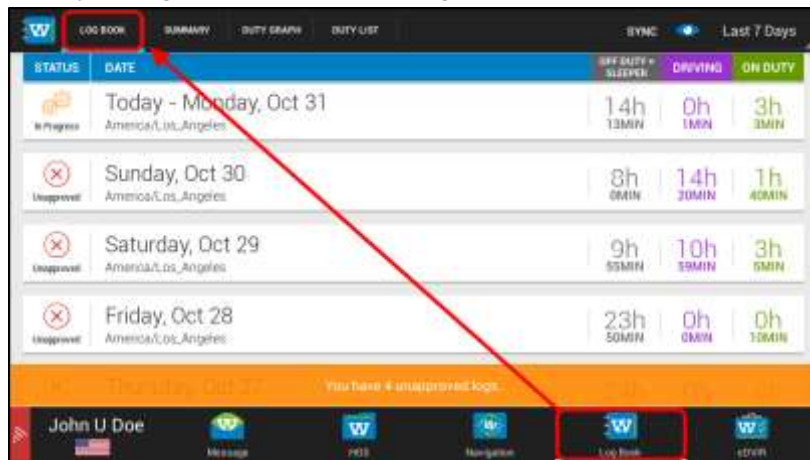

Presenting Logs for Inspection

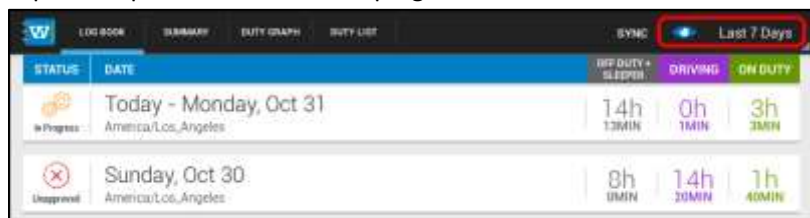
Upon roadside inspection by a compliance officer, you will need to present your HOS logs. Here's how to do this:

Driver Instructions

1. Go to your **Log Book** and select the **Log Book** tab.



2. Tap the inspection icon at the top right.



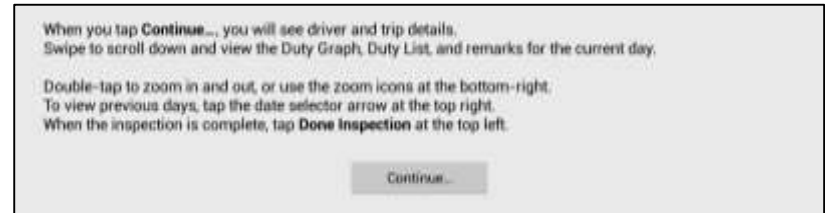
3. In the dialog that appears, tap **Begin Inspection** and give the officer access to your device.



Remember to log back into Driver Center after the officer has finished their inspection.

Officer Instructions

1. You will see an overview of how to inspect the driver's log.

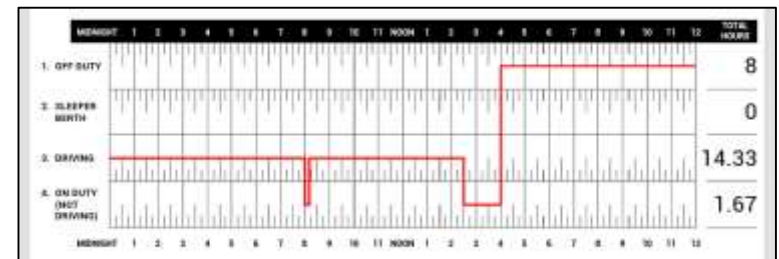


2. Switch between days using the arrows at the top right. For each day, you can review the following information:

- a. General info such as the date, driver name, vehicle info, etc.:

- c. A log of every duty status change for the day:
