

Driver's Guide to Data Transfer During Roadside Inspection

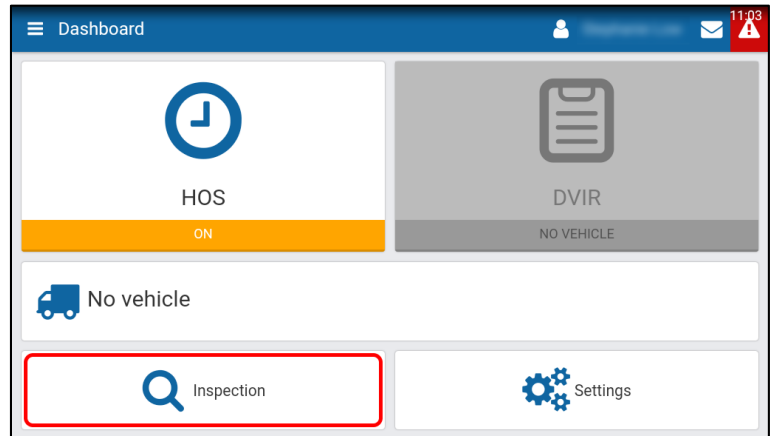
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NOTE: This document must be kept in the Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) at all times, and be made available during a roadside inspection in accordance to §395.22 (h). The application supports the telematics transfer, which electronically transfers data to an authorized safety officer on demand via wireless Web Services and Email (Option 1). For more details, see 49 CFR Part 395, Appendix A to Subpart B – Electronic Logging Devices (Section 4.9.1).

Roadside Inspections

In the event of a roadside inspection:

1. From the Dashboard, tap **Inspection** at the bottom left.
2. Do one of the following:

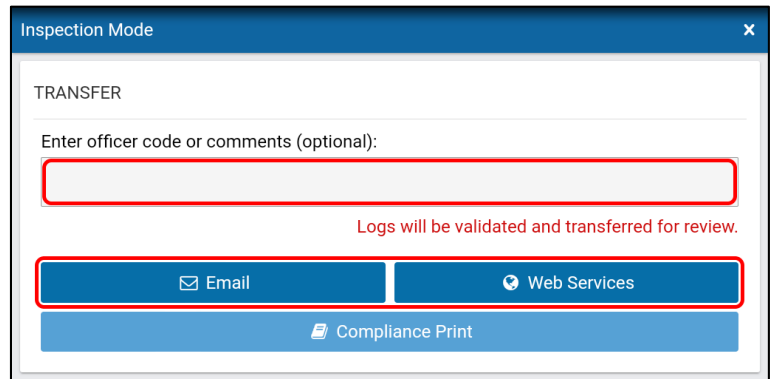


Option 1 – Transfer your logs

You can send your logs to the FMCSA for later inspection.

NOTE: This requires an internet connection.

1. In the text box, enter the code provided by the officer.
2. Tap **Email** or **Web Services** to transfer the report to the FMCSA.



Option 2 – Display your logs on your mobile device

You can tap **Compliance Print** to display your logs in the application. The officer can then review your logs directly on the mobile device.

This is used for situations where you don't have reliable cellular network coverage, or if the **Email** and **Web Services** transfer options fail.

3. To exit **Inspection Mode**, tap the **X** at the top right of the screen.
